Guidelines

Candidates for the Christina and Lawrence Tarbell III *Scholarship* **must attend Howard High for two out of three years and:**

1. Plan to attend a two- or four-year college/university or trade school.
2. Submit an essay of no more than 500 words that covers the following topics:
 - a. Educational Plans
 - b. Career Goals
 - c. The impact this scholarship will have on educational plans & career goals.
3. Provide one personal letter of recommendation.
4. Include the check list from one academic teacher and/or employment supervisor.
5. Have a 3.5 cumulative average through Grade 11. In addition, a grade of 3.5 must be maintained through the first semester of Grade 12.
6. Be accepted at an accredited institution.
7. Up to five scholarship applications will be accepted annually from Howard High School from which the Scholarship Review Committee will select a winner

Evaluation Criteria

All applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

1. Confidential teacher evaluation.
2. Student Essay.
3. Strength of student's transcript.
4. Need will be used in case of a tie.
